
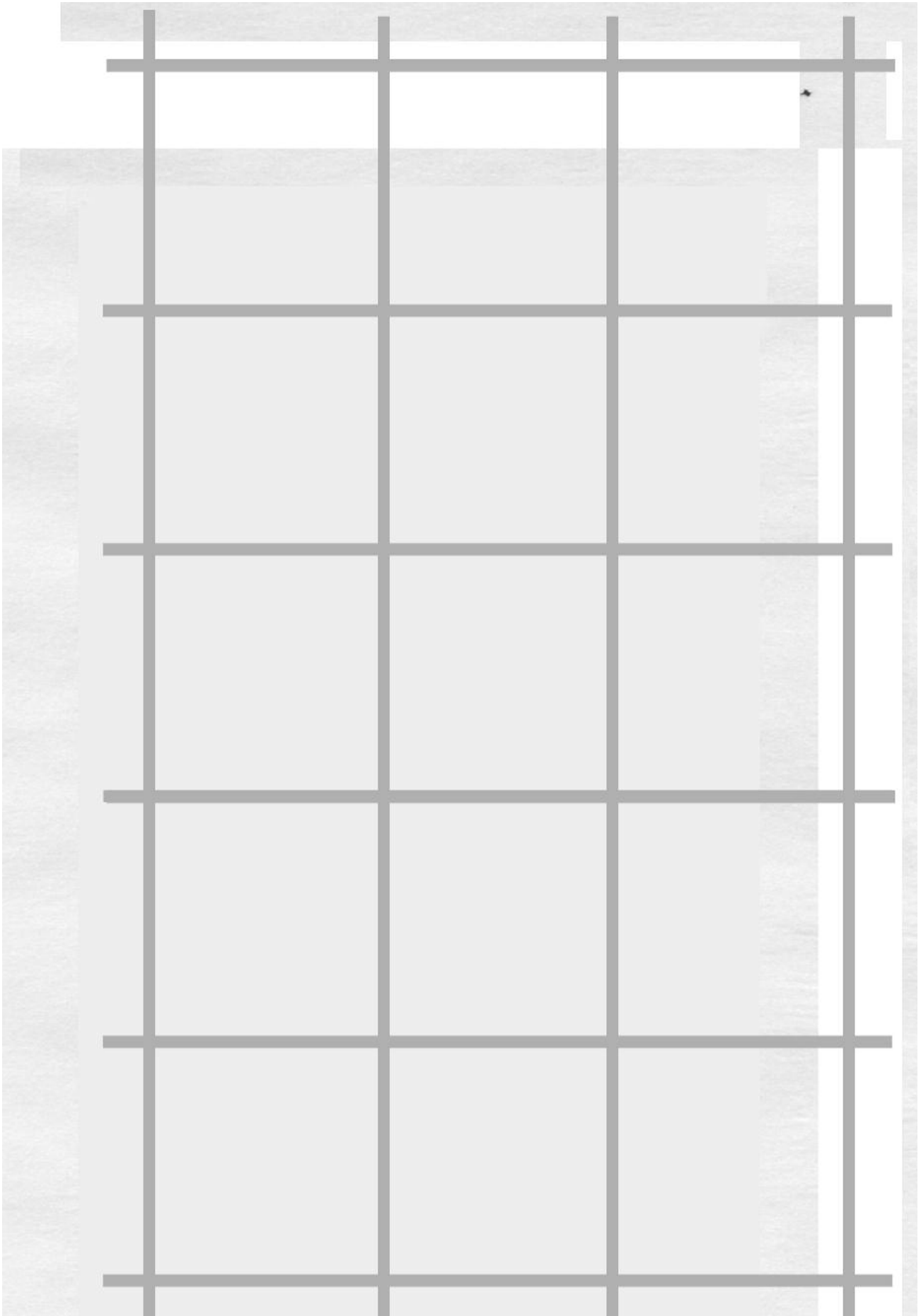

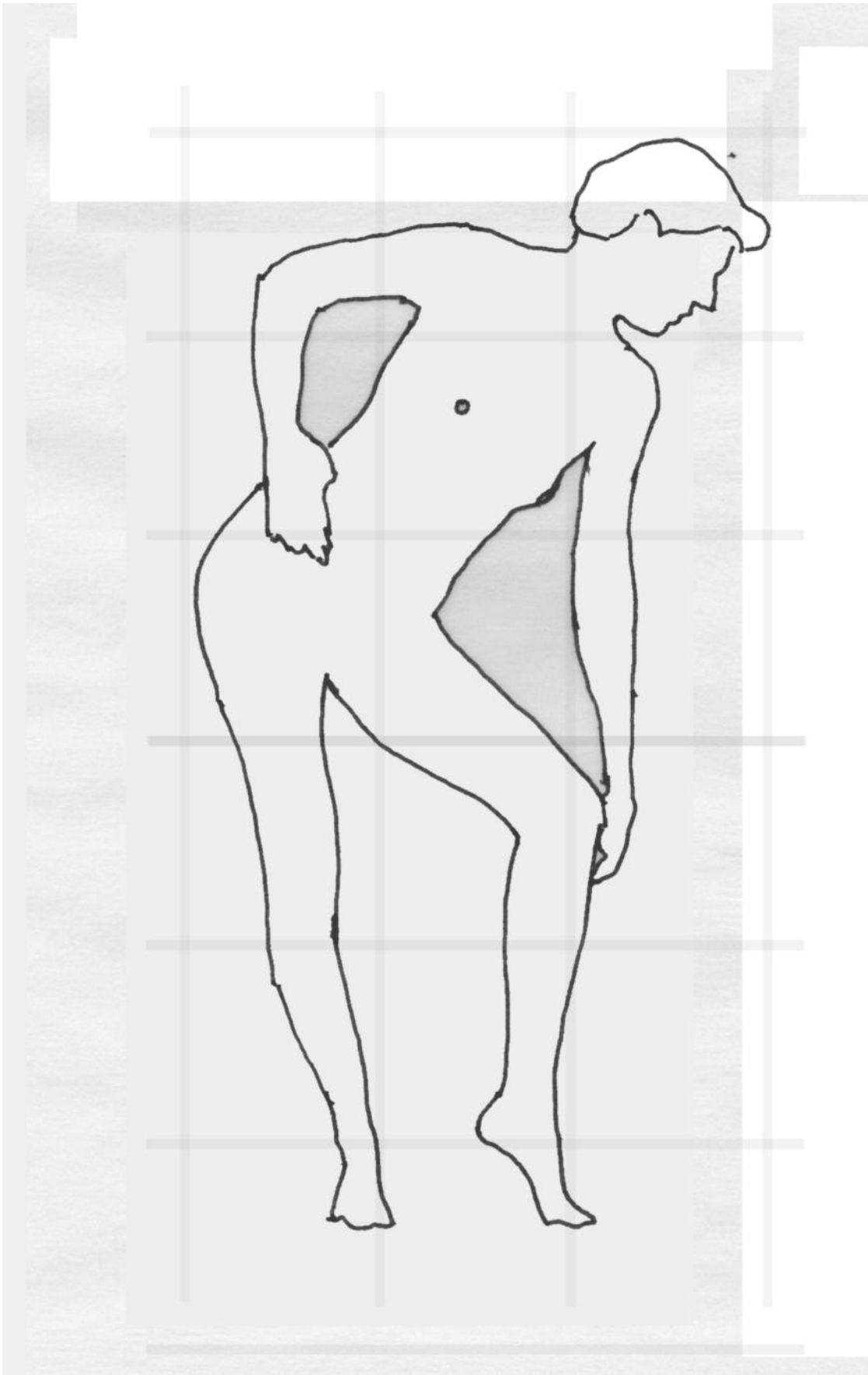
Have a Copy Shop like Kinko's print this page onto clear acetate. Attach with Spray Mount to a sheet of (Utrecht has Midwest brand) clear acrylic, about .03 mil thick.

Focus on framing the head length into a single box (1" x 1") which bounds the head from the top to the chin. This box will serve as your measuring stick for the pose. Then count the number of boxes (5.5) until you reach the full length of the model. You now know how many heads tall the model is in this pose. Also count the number of boxes (3) the model fills from side to side.



Draw grid onto the canvas or paper. You can mark off the corner of a piece of paper for the 1-head unit. There is some trial and error as you fit the grid onto canvas or paper.



Our rough outline will assure that the figure is in proportion. You can also use the grid to check vertical and horizontal alignments---back of head to toe, for example.
